

The Ramona Food & Clothes Closet, Inc (RFCC) is seeking a licensed solar vendor (SV) to design and install a solar PV system at 773 Main St, Ramona, CA. RFCC was awarded a contract by the County of San Diego to purchase and install a solar system to reduce utility costs. This project must be done in accordance with the U.S. Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant program regulations.

This system shall be in the parking lot on an elevated shade structure to be provided by the SV. The notional system size is 50kW DC. Roof mounted solutions will not be considered. key personnel, exchange  
contact information, review the  
contract, discuss expectations,  
and next steps.
